

ILAE Actions to Support People with Epilepsy Affected by the Situation in Ukraine



Work with all affected ILAE chapters to assess medical needs, including supplies of anti-seizure and rescue medications



Liaise with pharmaceutical companies and humanitarian partners to facilitate ongoing supplies of life saving medications for people with epilepsy



Develop guidelines for clinicians in affected countries on different medical formularies and, if needed, how to safely change prescriptions for anti-seizure medication



Translate essential epilepsy-related phrases and terms into all commonly used languages to help with clinician-patient communication



Fundraise to provide mobile phones and pre-paid SIM cards for people with epilepsy to allow for connecting with services, medical record keeping, and psychosocial support



Develop clinical networks to assist with referrals and to support front-line clinicians accessing expert advice on epilepsy



Advocate with all governments for free treatment for all people with epilepsy and engage with humanitarian partners to promote including essential anti-seizure medications in all emergency medical supplies
